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Minutes of the District Development Committee(DDC) Meeting for the month of April,2023 held on 12-04-2023 at 11.00 am in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner's Office , Nalbari

The meeting was chaired by Sri Gitimoni Phukan, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari and welcomed all the District Heads of various departments of Nalbari District present in the meeting and started discussion as per agenda along with the Power Point Presentation (PPT) of the departments on monitorable targets and actionable points of the next DCs Conference with Hon'ble CM will be held in the 2nd week of May/23 at Tinsukia.
