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Minutes of the District Development Committee(DDC) Meeting for the month of February, 2023 held on 07-02-2023 at 11.00 am in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner's Office, Nalbari

The meeting was chaired by Sri Gitimoni Phukan, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari and welcomed all the District Heads of various departments of Nalbari District present in the meeting.
