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**Minutes of the District Development Committee(DDC) Meeting for the month of January,2023 held on 19-01-2023 at 11.00 am in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner's Office , Nalbari**

The meeting was chaired by Sri Gitimoni Phukan, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari and welcomed Hon'ble MLA Shri Jayanta Malla Baruah and all District Heads of various departments of Nalbari District present in the meeting.

The Hon'ble MLA Shri Jayanta Malla Baruah also welcomed the members present in the meeting, He then informed about the death of prominent Poet Kavyarishi Sri Nilmani Phookan and the house one minute condolence for his departed soul.

Then the meeting was started with Power Point Presentation(PPT) as submitted by the departments and the house reviewed the progress of different schemes and after detailed discussions on the schemes/projects, schematic progress, status reports and actionable points submitted by the departments, the following resolutions were adopted by the house:

Departments	Discussions and actions
<b>Drainage system in Nalbari district</b>	The Hon'ble MLA Nalbari told about the improvement and beautification of Nalbari Town & construction of proper drainage system, footpath, median, road etc under SOPD-G. The MLA suggested that the drain should be 1.30 meters wide and the road should be maximum 16 meters and minimum 14 meters from the centre of the road. The footpath may be compromised in sensitive points.(In case of damage to private property then the issue should be amicably solved). The E.E. said the house that in Palla road, N.T.Road, Hajo road lay out was completed & PCC to be constructed under drain where there is no PCC and also Load bearing slab will be constructed over footpath so that the road can be expanded as far as possible. ( Action: E.E.PWD (TR) Division)
<b>Paddy Procurement</b>	As replied by the DAO the Paddy procurement under KMS, FY 2022-23 1 <sup>st</sup> Crop achievement till January is 2,222 MT against the total target of 22500 MT. The DAO also informed that VLW list with phone number has already been submitted to the Hon'ble Minister. The DAO is instructed to submit the same list to the Deputy Commissioner. The Hon'ble MLA confirmed that NAFED took one month for clearing the payment for the paddy. The Hon'ble MLA requested the DC to arrange a meeting with NAFDA for clearance of payments within a week in future. ( Action: DAO, Agriculture)



<b>Orunodoy</b>	The Hon`ble MLA informed that panchayat wise Orunodoy beneficiaries data received will be finalized in the next DLMC meeting.  (Action: DDC & SPO,T&D Branch)
<b>NAFS Card</b>	The Hon`ble MLA told that a verification on the existing 39628 nos of NAFS card is required. It should be done through the BLO and stern action be taken in case of defective of any fake card holders. It is also told by the Hon`ble MLA that there is still 8000 nos of deserving families in Nalbari LAC to get the NAFS cards. The DDS to take immediate necessary action for covering the eight thousand beneficiaries under NAFS . (Action: DDS, FCS&CA)
<b>Ayushman bharat</b>	Hon`ble MLA informed that the NAFS card holders will get the benefit of Ayushman bharat scheme. He also told that compliance of demanding money has been received for making Ayushman card from some beneficiaries. Awareness campaign is to be taken through ASHA, Booth level workers etc. in the villages after 26 <sup>th</sup> January. (Action: ADC(H),Jt. Director, Health)
<b>PMAY(A+)</b>	The CEO, Zilla Parishad informed that total 5752 nos of PMAY(A+) houses have been sanctioned in the district in which Borigog Banbhag-953 nos and Pub-nalbari-780 nos of houses is completed. In Nalbari LAC 100% houses have been completed. He also asked the CEO to submit the block wise both PMAY & PMAY(A+) list to the him. (Action: CEO, Zilla Parishad)
<b>Akshya Patra &amp; VGR land</b>	Hon`ble Minister to submit VGR land allotment proposals to the Govt. immediately. He also instructed to submit proposal to govt. for Akshya patra kitchen and Cluster PMAY from VGR land . (Action: ADC,(Revenue)
<b>Planetarium</b>	The DEEO & curator stated that from 8 <sup>th</sup> Feb/22 to 17 <sup>th</sup> Jan/23, revenue of Rs: 1.5 Lakh collected from visitors. The MLA asked the management for preparation of a tentative budget for maintenance of Planetarium for next budget session.
<b>Gurdon School</b>	Hon`ble MLA told that Gurdon school to be developed as Model ITI and it should be completed by August/23. (Action:Inspector of Schools,Nalbari
<b>Land Compensation</b>	Hon`ble MLA told that complaints have been received from public regarding land compensation. He said that some discrepancies in the award list has been observed. A verification in this regard is required. (Action: ADC(LA)
<b>Social Welfare</b>	As replied by the DSWO 10 nos of AWCs are inaugurated and 16 nos are ready for inauguration by this month. He also informed that another 49 nos of AWCs sanctioned in this year. The Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari asked him to take necessary action to start construction of remaining AWCs as soon as possible . (Action: DSWO,Nalbari)



<b>Transport</b>	<p>The DTO informed the house that regular checking is going on to stop over speeding of vehicle, drunken driving , use of mobile phone while driving, non wearing of helmets, overloading etc. to decrease the incident of road accidents. The DTO also stated that till december/22Rs.18.00 lakh revenue was collected out of total target of 25 Cr. The DTO told to take necessary action to increase the revenue to achieve the target.</p> <p>(Action: DTO, Nalbari)</p>
<b>Health</b>	<p>The Deputy commissioner requested the Jt. Director of health services to maintain formalities in case of suspected deaths. This should be informed by the Police Deptt, Nalbari. He was also asked to take necessary steps for minimizing the Infant Mortality Rate in the district.</p> <p>(Action: Jt. Director, Nalbari)</p>
<b>Irrigation</b>	<p>Deputy Commissioner informed the E.E. Irrigation that complaints are received regarding non receipt of the Solar Pumps by the genuine farmers and asked the E.E.to check it and report within 10 days.</p> <p>(Action: E.E. Irrigation, Nalbari)</p>

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks from the chair.
