The **District Development Committee (DDC)** meeting was chaired by Sri Nibedan Das Patowary, ACS, District Commissioner, Nalbari. At the outset, the indicators for District ranking under the CM Dashboard were comprehensively reviewed.

Then the meeting commenced with a review of the action taken points from the previous DDC meeting followed by Power Point presentations from the Heads of Departments on the progress of various schemes, which were then reviewed by the house.
