Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) Meeting, Nalbari held on 05-01-2022 at 11.00 A.M. in the auditorium hall of Bornibari Model village.

Members present - As per Annexure - 'A'.

The District Development Committee meeting was held in the Bornibari Adarxo village.

Smti Gitimoni Phukan, ACS Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari presided over the meeting and welcomed all Head of Development Departments present.

She then told that the next DC's Conference with Hon'ble Chief Minister is likely to be held shortly, so the updated reports submitted by Departments on the Actionable Points and Monitorable target will be discussed in the meeting.

Sri Narnarayan Nath, ACS, DDC said that most of departments delay in submitting reports, resulting delay in uploading the same in the portal. He requested all the departments to furnish their reports on time.

A power point presentation on the updated follow up action taken by the departments against all the 99 Actionable points and 56 Monitorable targets was given by the DDC on the basis of the reports received from the departments.

During the presentation, the following department wise Action Points were fixed identified and asked for compliance.

- immediate necessary action for completion of ongoing schemes and to make necessary arrangement for fulfilment of requirement of the village. Apart from these the Deputy Commissioner also asked to do the following works in the village to the concerned departments:
 - (a) Setting up of a new FP shop in the village.
 - (b) FHTC to every house hold.
 - (c) Allotment of land for playground and landless families.
 - (d) Extension of Irrigation canal.
 - (e) Construction of remaining IHHL of needy beneficiaries.
 - (f) The DSO to organize a football training camp for talent search.

The District Development Commissioner reviewed the last DDC meeting minutes and confirmed the same.

- Education: Reviewing the last DDC minutes the District Development Commissioner instructed the DEEO cum DMC, SSA to complete construction of ramps at the earliest.
 - The Deputy Commissioner also opined that reading and spelling capacity of the students needs to be improved. The DEEO was asked to look into the matter.
- (2) Industries: The I/c GM, DI&CC has intimated that they have organized 2 awareness camp for moral support to local entrepreneur on GST exemption and other incentives. The GM, DI&CC to arrange meeting with FCS&CA for submission of proposal for subsidized dryer to Mill owner.
- (3) PWD (Territorial) Road: The Executive Engineer, PWD (T) Nalbari presented PPT on progress of departmental activities as follows:
